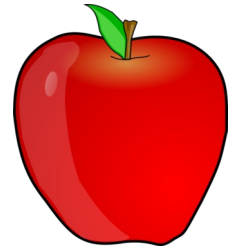

Michigan Student Test of Education Progress

April 2016

Barhitte Students in Grades 3-5 will be taking the State Mandated M-STEP Test.

The M-STEP test is Michigan's assessment of a student's performance as compared to the grade level state standards.

English, language arts and mathematics are given to students in grades 3-5, Science is administered in grade 4. Students in grade 5 will be assessed in Social Studies.

The testing schedule is as follows:

5th Grade April 12-29
3rd Grade April 25-May 13
4th Grade May 9-27

The following are ways to help your child to do well on the assessment:

- ◆ Be sure your child attends school on the days the test is given.
- ◆ Make certain your child gets a good night's sleep.
- ◆ Provide a good breakfast or encourage your child to eat breakfast at school on the mornings of testing.
- ◆ Let your child know that you are confident that he/she will do well.

Congratulations to participants Madison Bell and Makayla Moran for presenting their projects.

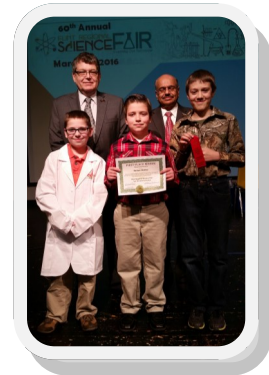
